

APPENDIX 1.

ORARA VALLEY ANGLICANS

There are 3 centres of Anglican Worship in the Orara Valley.

**Christ Church, Glenreagh Worship Times: 8.00am Sunday.
 9.30am Combined Service
 on the 5th Sunday of the month.**

Christ Church Glenreagh is a timber building which was constructed in 1914.

The current worshipping congregation is an aging one and is small in size (8-15 people). There is a Licensed Lay Minister assigned to Glenreagh.

The Glenreagh Village Markets, which are held on the first Saturday of every month [except January] were an initiative of the congregation through their association with the Glenreagh School of Arts. The parish currently offers a morning tea at the markets, which is seen as a fund raiser for the parish and a connection with the wider community.

**St. Peter's, Nana Glen Worship Times: 9.30am Sunday.
 9.30am Combined Service
 on the 5th Sunday of the month.**

The current worshipping congregation is small but dedicated. Worship alternates between Morning Prayer and the Eucharist.

There are two Licensed Lay Ministers assigned to St. Peter's Nana Glen, who are a husband and wife team.

St. Peter's has a small office/meeting area adjacent to the Church. This area is used as a meeting room for the parish. Parish Council meets here on the 2nd Sunday of the month at 11am.

As noted above the parish comes together to support the ministry initiative of the Glenreagh Village Markets.

**St. Paul's Coramba Worship Times: 9.30am Sunday.
 9.30am Combined Service
 on the 5th Sunday of the month.**

St Paul's offers a weekly service at 9.30am. The services alternate between Morning Prayer and the Eucharist. The congregation ranges from 5-15 people.

There is a Licensed Lay Minister assigned to St. Paul's.
